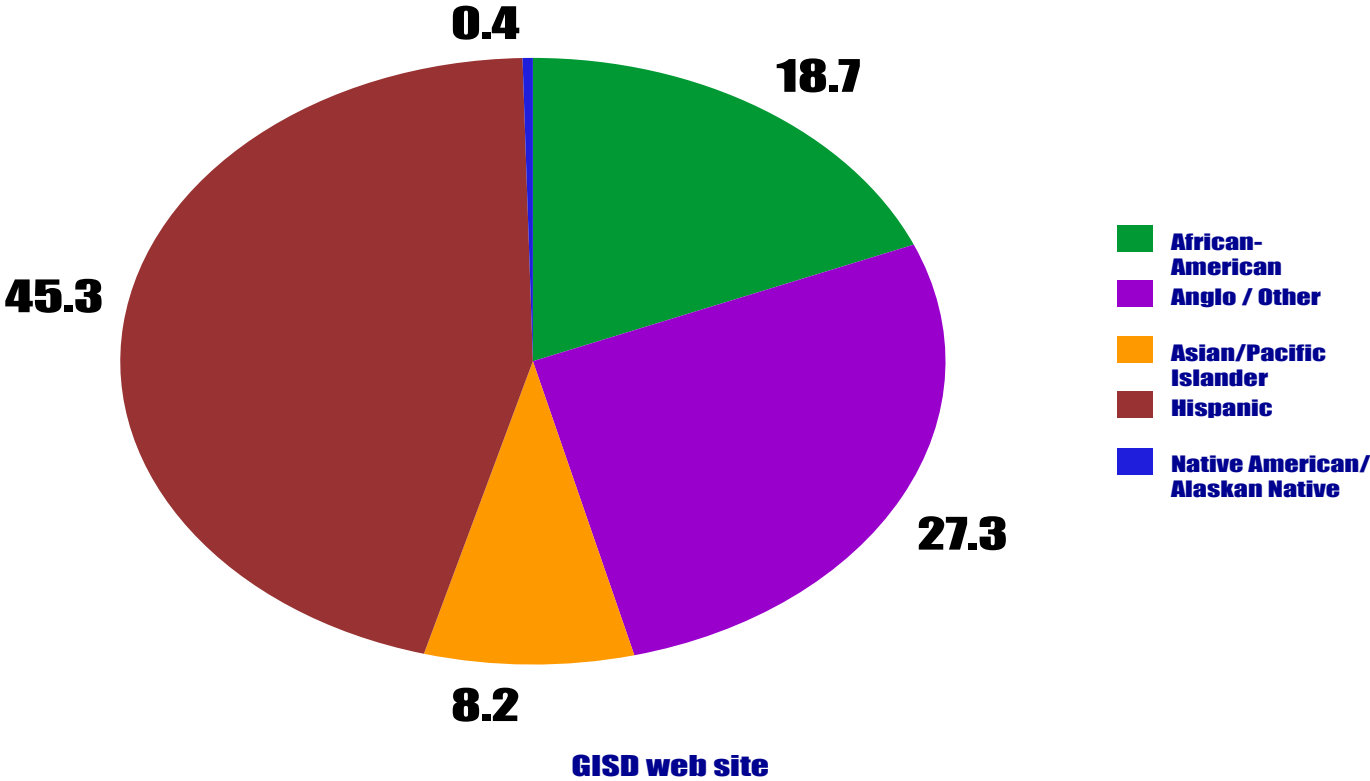

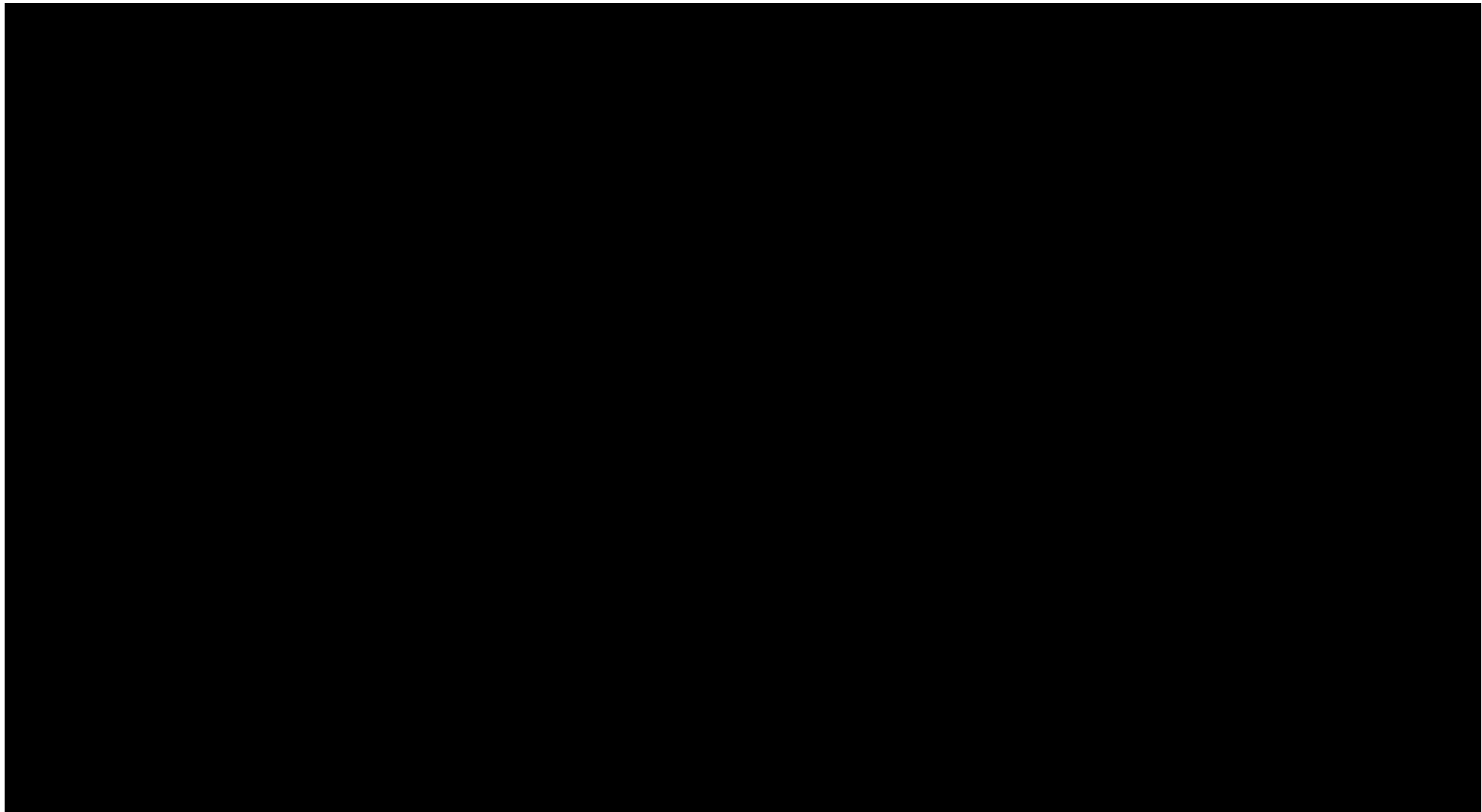

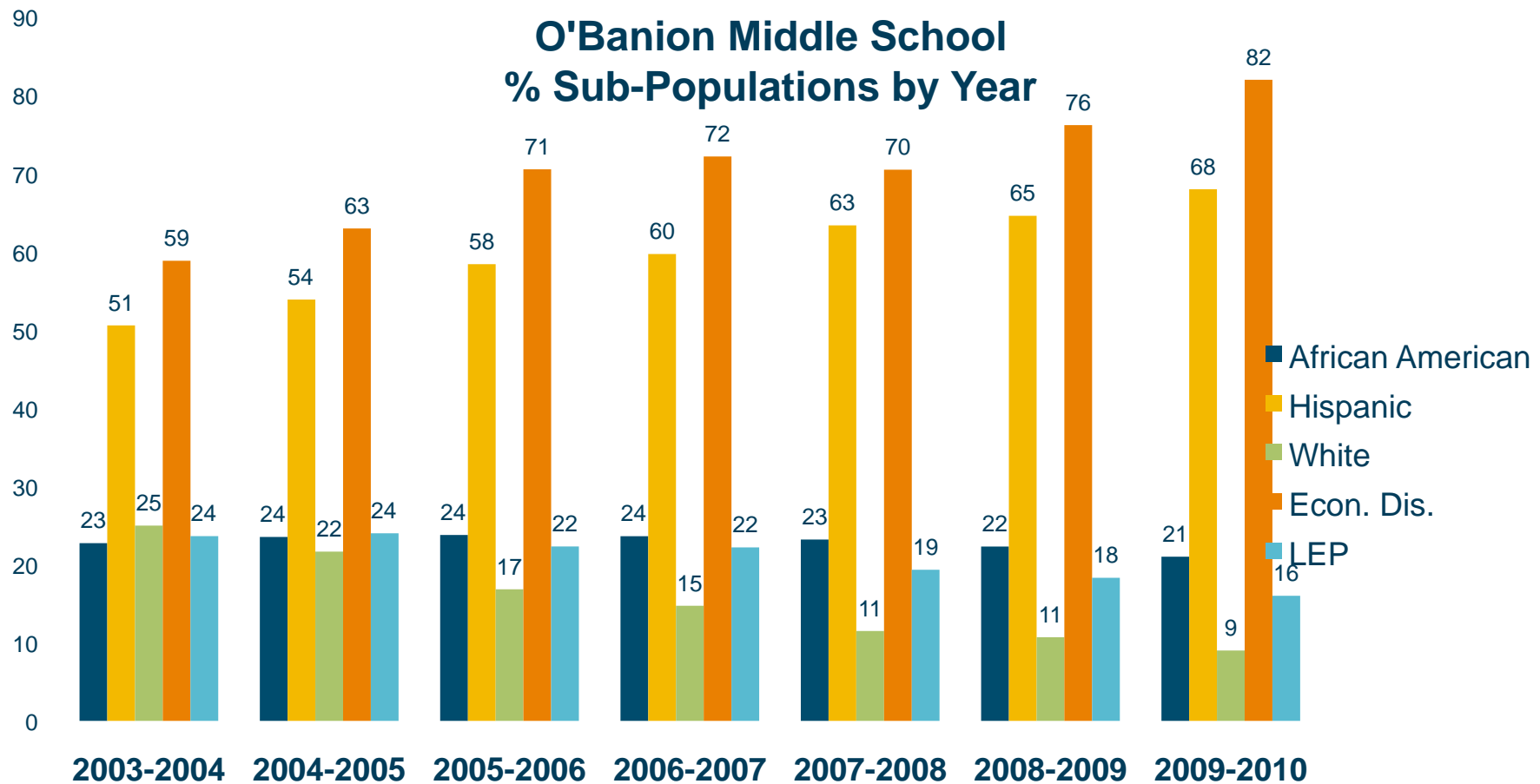

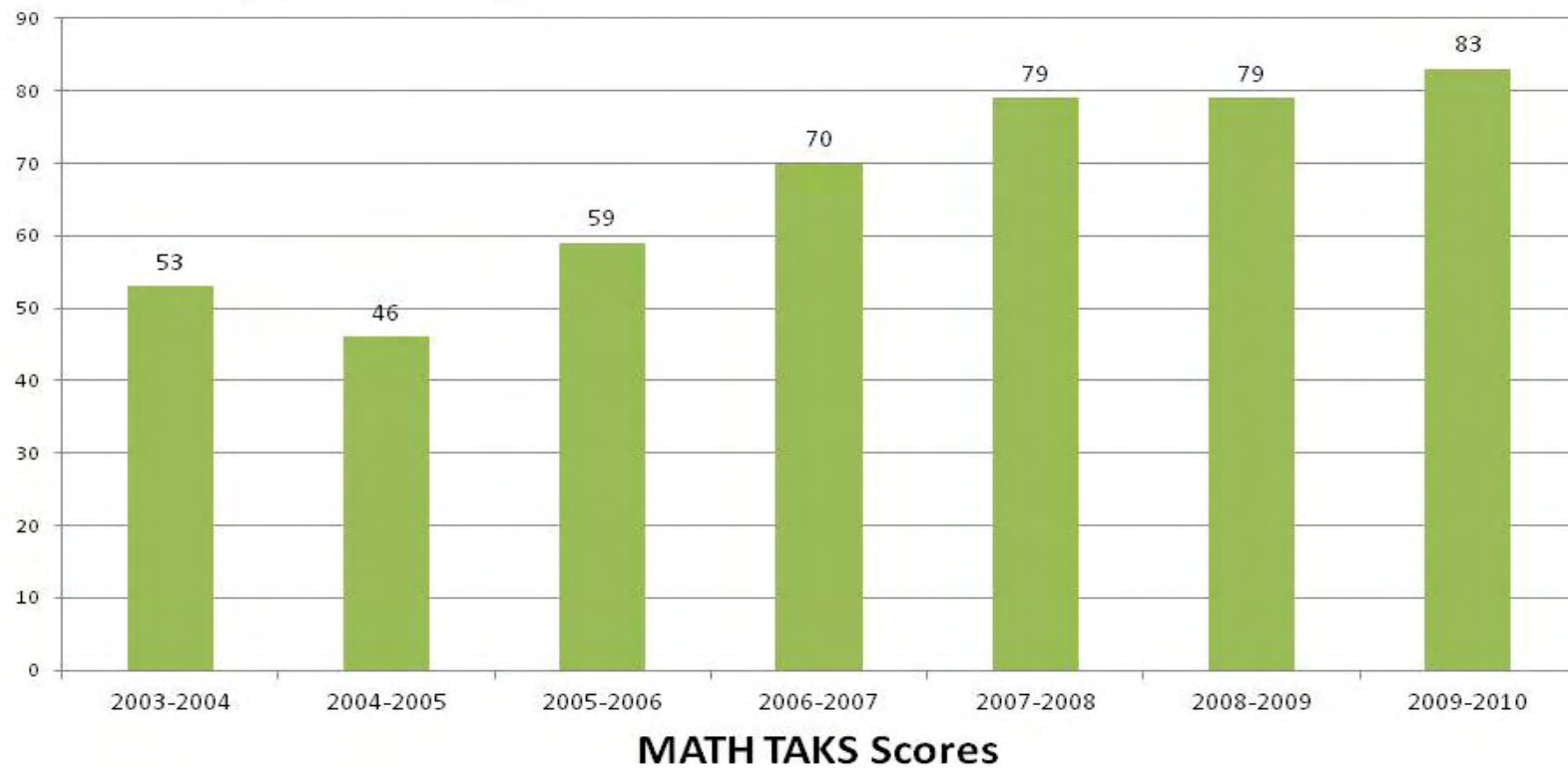
O'Banion Middle School Demographics



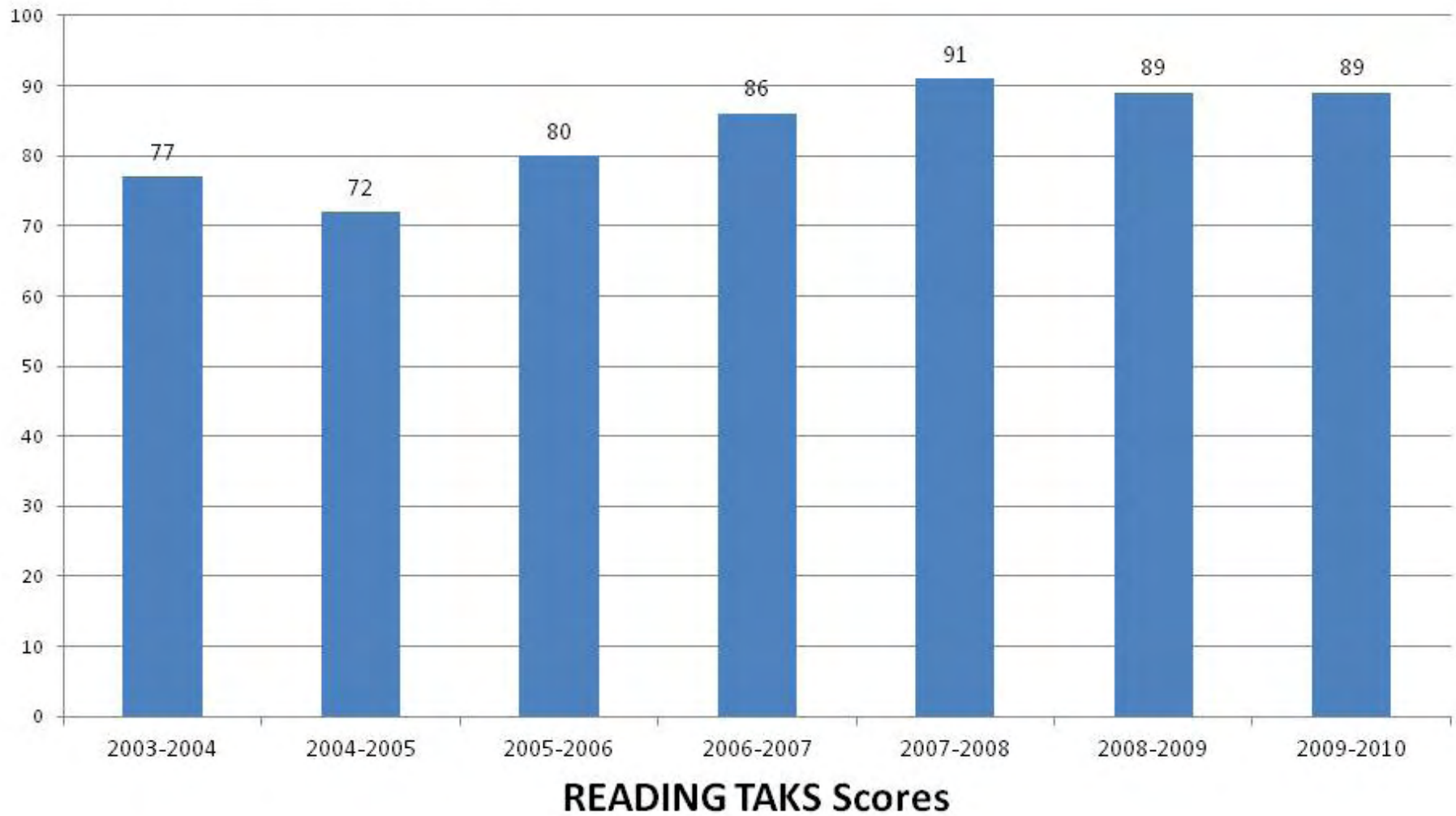
O'Banion Math TAKS



O'Banion Middle School Year-by-Year Comparison



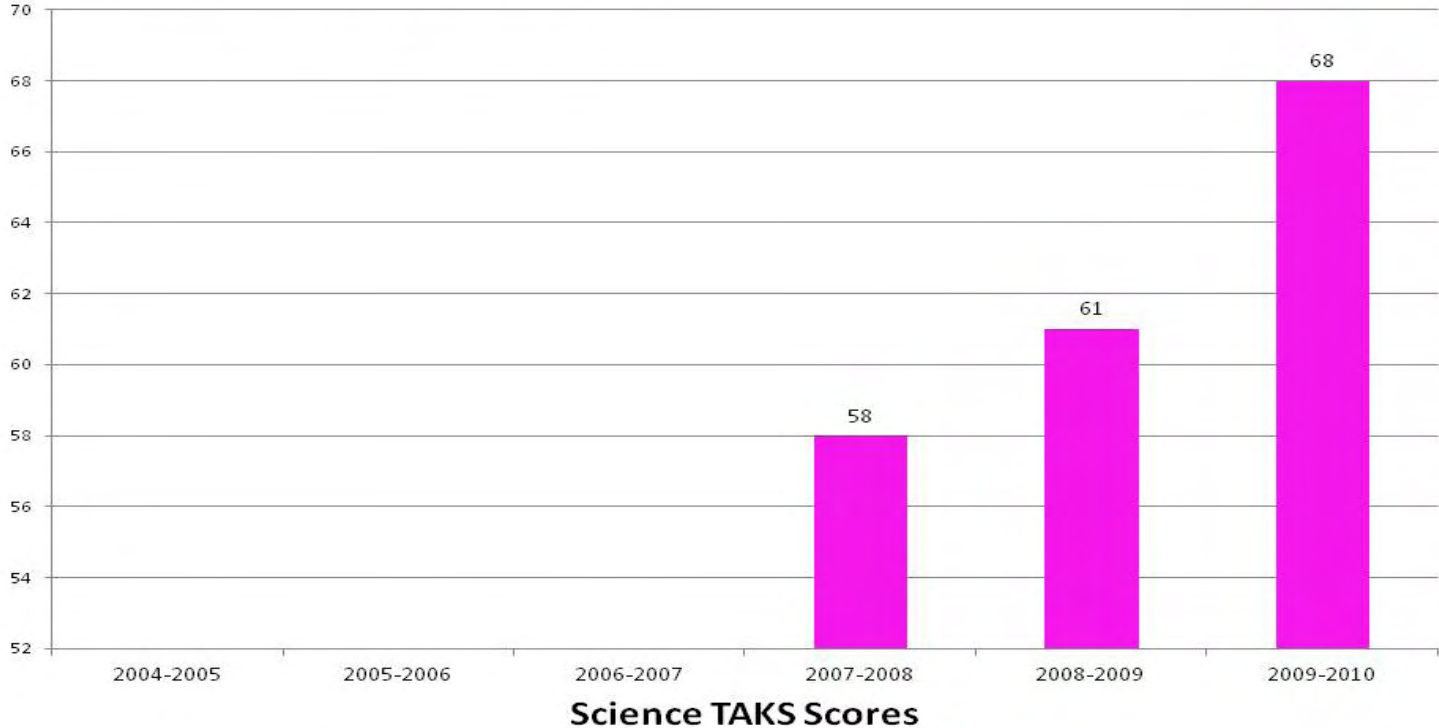

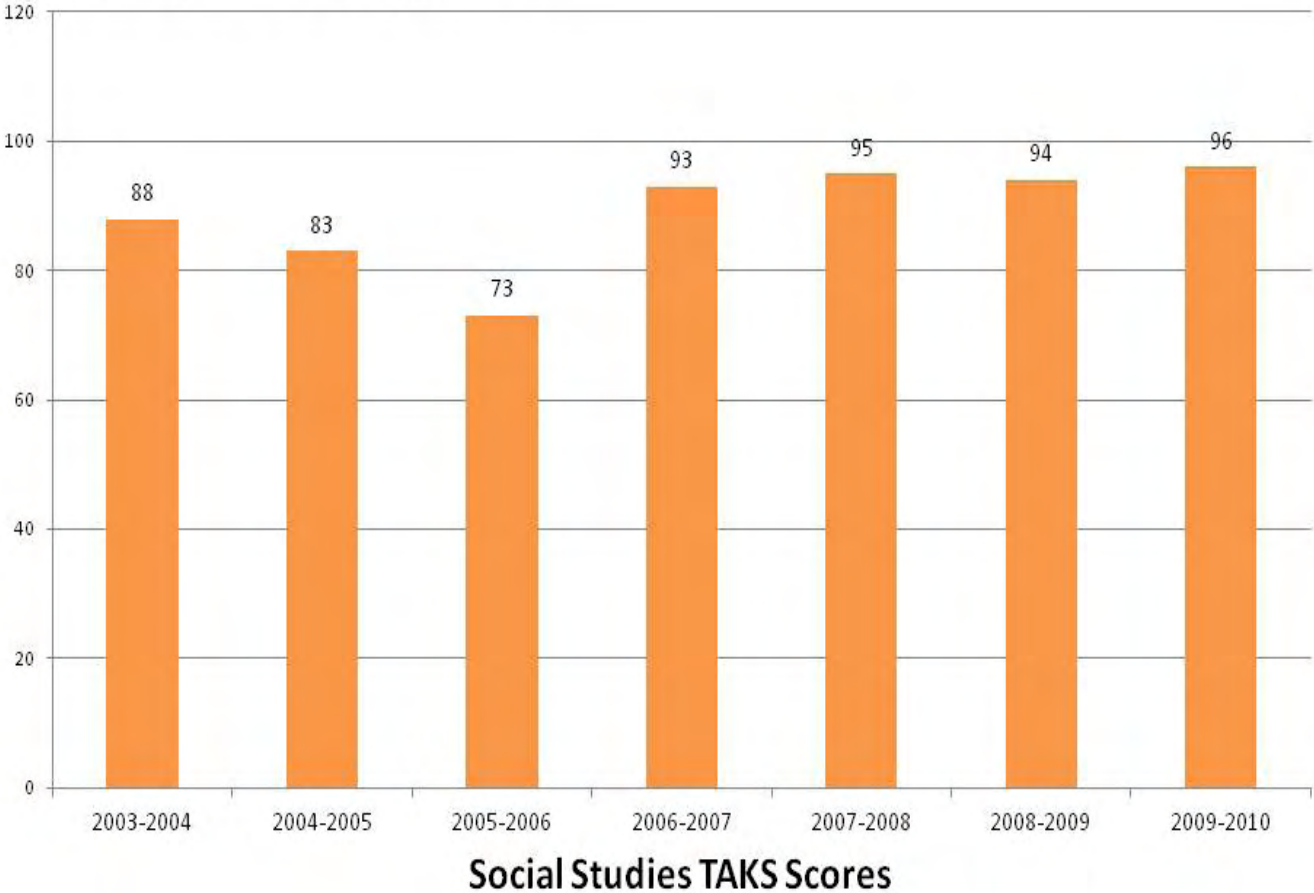

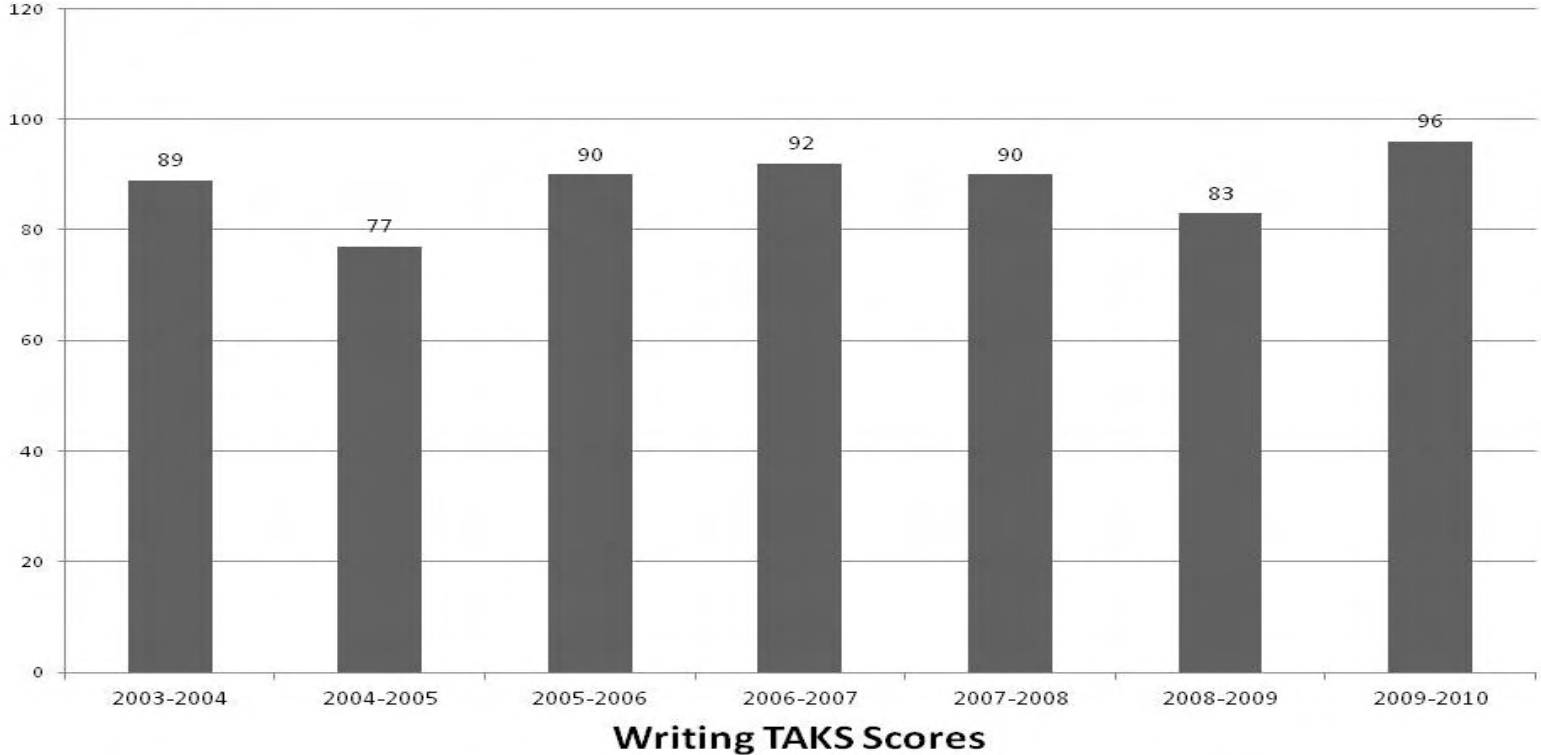

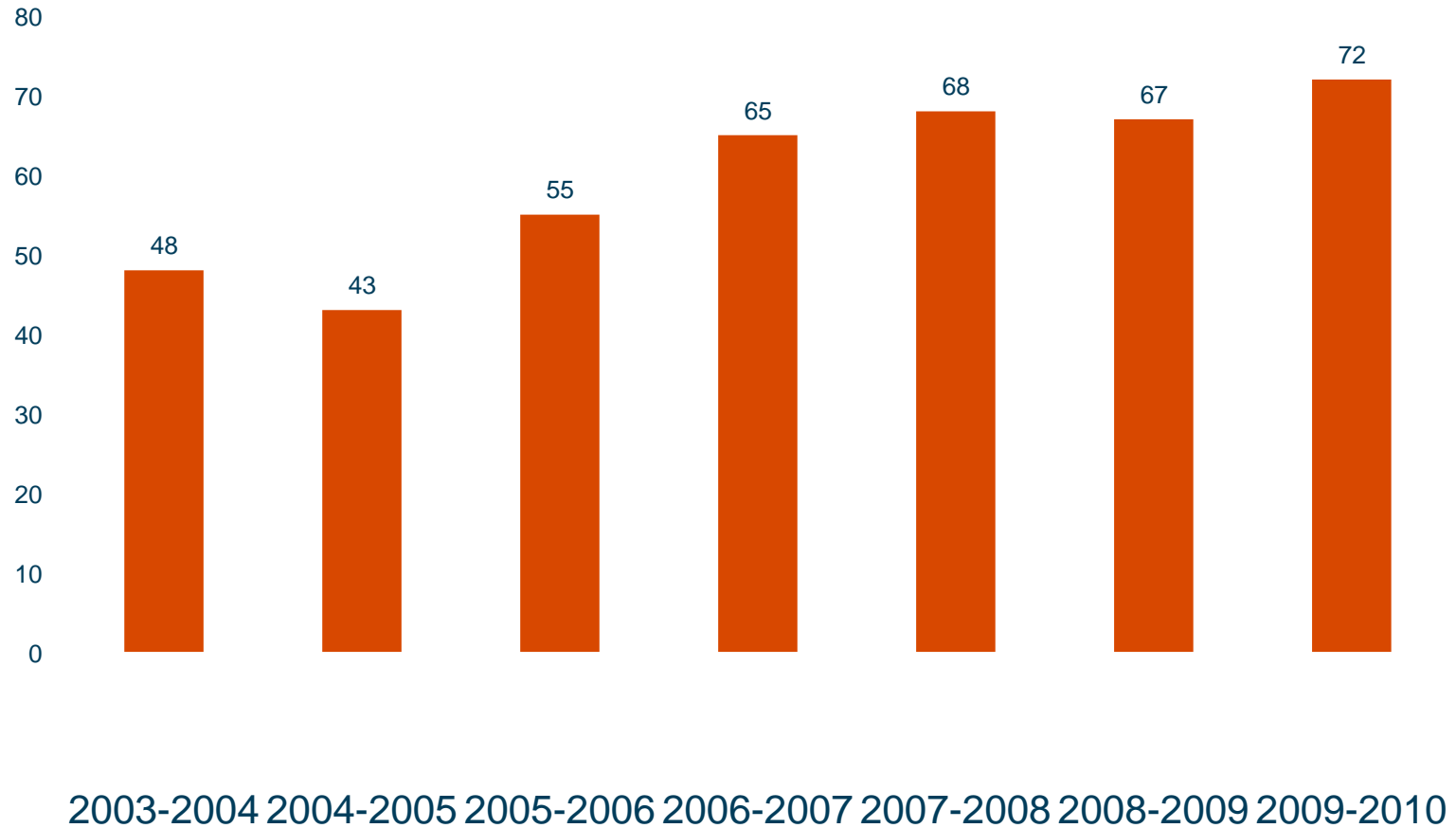

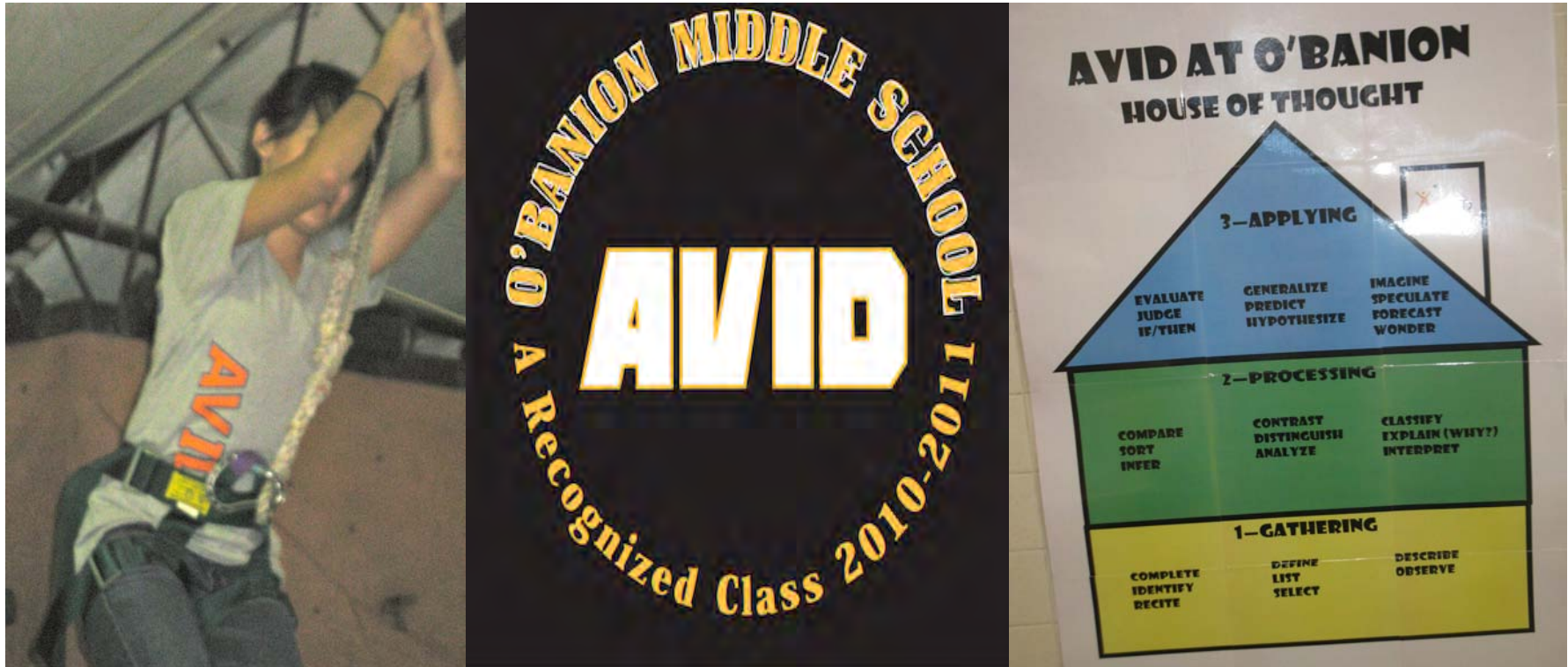
