## Get Set.

The following are required steps for AVID Postsecondary Implementation:

- Commit to a multi-year planning and implementation cycle
- Establish a “freshman experience course” that will use AVID instructional strategies and support systems
- Form a Campus Team that will develop an annual campus plan addressing the AVID Postsecondary Core Principles
- Identify and recruit students who are from traditionally underrepresented ethnic and/or low-income groups
- Develop a learning community to bring coherence and contextual opportunity for AVID postsecondary students
- Commit to a professional development plan, including attendance by a team at an AVID Summer Institute
- Recruit and employ a staff of college tutors who are then trained using AVID methodologies
- Examine policies and procedures that would give students accelerated access to credit bearing courses, thereby reducing the amount of time in developmental courses
